The Loup County Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment this 12th day of April, 2023 at 1:00P.M. at the Loup County Courthouse in Taylor, Nebraska. Present were Commissioners Larson, Steckel and Ruppel, County Clerk Ruzicka, Steve Niemeyer, Beth Ferrell and Ed Sherbeck. County Attorney White and County Engineer Johnson were present later in the afternoon. Chairman Larson called the meeting to order. Board members acknowledged receipt of the March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023 meeting minutes with no corrections or additions to same. Funds. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steckel. Roll call vote; yes; Larson, Steckel and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none. Said resolution can be found in Commissioners Record No. 10 Page 302.

The Board discussed with Hwy Superintendent Johnson the project on 823<sup>rd</sup> Road. Johnson confirmed it has been surveyed and is 2-3 months out from the bid process. The porcupine bridge project was also discussed, it will likely be bid in June. Finally, they discussed the project on 822<sup>nd</sup> road, as it is located on the Custer County line, it was suggested that we bill the Township for half of the project to rebuild the road. Ed Sherbeck discussed the new bridge planks for Almeria that were received, may not be enough to replace everything that needs it.

An invoice from Spelt's for fencing supplies was discussed by the board. Fence was damaged by a county employee and County Attorney advised the county pay for the replacement of the fence. Steve Niemeyer was present to introduce himself to Chairman Larson and give an overview of what the GLW does.

Beth Ferrel with NACO met with the board to give updated on events and legislation. Topics discussed were; county board, board of equalization, clerk, treasurer and assessor workshops, protest appeals, Legislation workshop, annual conference, NACO's new facility, scholarships available through NACO, network security, and broadband.

It was brought to the board's attention that the new road signs have not been put up in district 3, the roadman for that district will be contacted to put together a plan to replace them.

Larson moved to run an ad in the Burwell Tribune and the Custer County Chief for a part-time road maintenance position. 2<sup>nd</sup> Ruppel. Roll call vote; yes; Larson, Steckel and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.
