Brown moved to allow the claims. 2nd by Ralls. Roll call vote; yes; Ralls, Brown and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none.

Ruppel moved for the adoption of a resolution transferring monies from the General Fund to the Road and Special Road Funds. 2nd by Ralls. Roll call vote; yes; Brown, Ralls and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none. Said resolution can be found in Commissioners Record No. 10 Page 267.

Ralls moved to reappoint Roye Lindsay and Karen Bugbee to the Loup County Visitors Committee for a two-year term ending December 2024. 2nd by Brown. Roll call vote; yes; Brown, Ralls and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none. Brown moved to increase the Road and Weed employee salaries by 9% for 2023. 2nd by Ralls. Roll call vote; yes; Brown, Ralls and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none.

County Clerk Ruzicka was able to find the information on the road located in 35-21-18 between Steckel's and the old Harvey place. The road was opened in May of 1909, there is no record of the road being closed. The new owners of the "old Harvey place" would like to put in a fence and would need to know where to put the fence. Brown moved to have a Road hearing for the purpose of closing said road south of Kovariks. 2nd by Ruppel. Roll call vote; yes; Brown, Ralls and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none. Discussion on the minimum maintenance road located past Jack Cram's in District #3 needing to be fixed. Commissioner Ruppel would like to meet with Commissioner Ralls to have him show him where the road needs improvement. The road needs to be passable up to where it was closed, currently cannot get down it with a semi. The road is used by several people.

Ralls moved to sign the year end certification of the Hwy superintendent. 2nd by Ruppel. Roll call vote; yes; Brown, Ralls and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none. Discussion on the National Functional Classification System Review, some additional roads may need to be added. We need to find out more information, what are the definitions of the different classes, what documentation is needed to change the class.

Brown moved to approve the amendment provided by Zoning Administrator Kyle Shepard for the cleaning up of several sections including the fees, number of survey copies and acreage amounts. 2nd by Ruppel. Roll call vote; yes; Brown, Ralls and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none.

Brown moved to approve the amendment provided by Zoning Administrator Kyle Shepard to remove the language providing the use of Personal Campsite in Rural Conservation zones. 2nd by Ruppel. Roll call vote; yes; Brown, Ralls and Ruppel. Nays; none absent; none not voting; none.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.
